

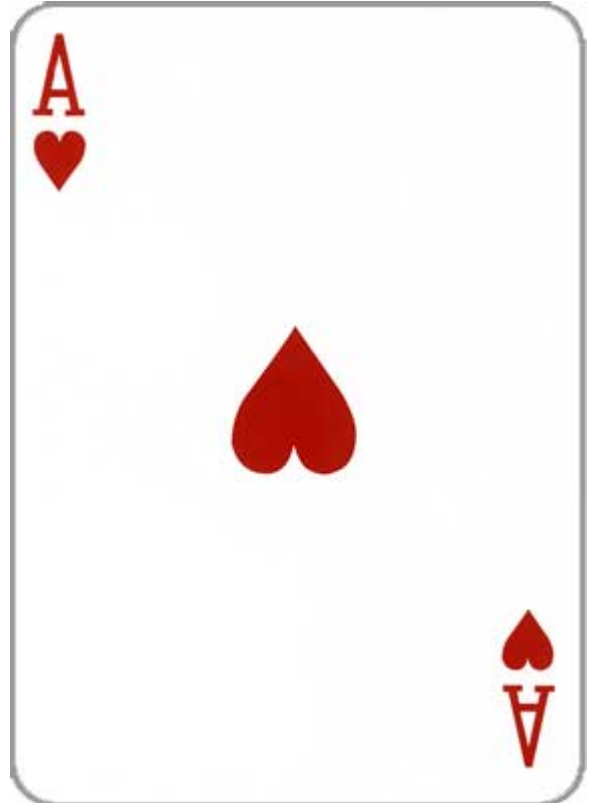
# *Birthday Cards*

## *Ace of Hearts:*

### *Compulsion for Adoration*

**Characteristics:** As the first card in the deck, the Ace of Hearts is the desire for love. Because of its Karma Card, however, the desire for finances is present too. It might be assumed that like Aries, being the first card in the deck and the first sign in the zodiac, these are young souls, prone to make a lot of errors and selfishness. With some, this is true, but it is by no means the majority. Lives as writers or in other creative occupations might bring success. They can be impulsive because they have a double-ace influence. Their last years will be the most meaningful of their entire life if they focus their attention on finding spiritual meaning. Changing values will be one of the biggest burdens to carry and they are often restless individuals. Fickleness and promiscuity should be avoided if they are ever to hope to discover the peace of mind they seek. High rewards come from finding an outlet for compassionate giving. Along with the



two Threes in their Life Path, their Karma Card gives them tremendous creative potential. However, the downside of this is indecision, worry and stress, because every gift can be a negative at times. Relaxation time away from their job is a healing remedy. These same Threes create the need for variety in work and a better structuring of their life and work. Allowing some flexibility helps them. All are Capricorns, so their work is important, as is the recognition it brings. Many of them, according to the Planetary Ruling Card, tell us that they will gain reputations as artists or creative persons. If they turn their pursuits in the direction of metaphysics and self-understanding a lot of difficulty in later life, both emotional and psychological, can be avoided. One of their main traits, courage, actually has this as a symbol. Combined with this courage is wisdom that is often misleading, but it does direct their actions towards success. Learning to look before they leap, the successful ones practice patience. Strong spiritual inclinations are part of people with this birth card, but they are frequently led astray by indecision and buried desires. **Relationships:** A search for love experiences at every corner and a kind of new adventure for the Ace of Hearts is being embarked on. Potential that has not yet been released is the zero. Counting from the Natural or Spiritual Spread, the Ace of Hearts card is the deck's first card.
