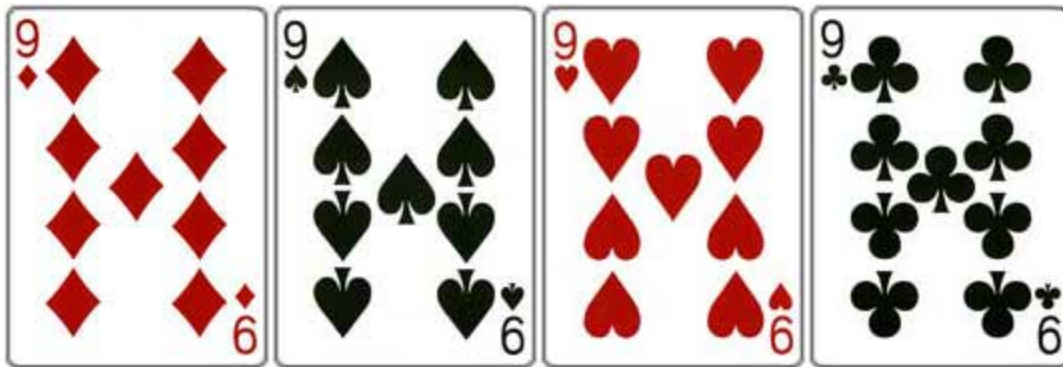


# *Birth Cards:*

## *Nines*

The most difficult task is probably done by the Nine of Spades for they must let go of their ego and give in to the will of God. The Nine of Spades in many ways has the strongest burden.
