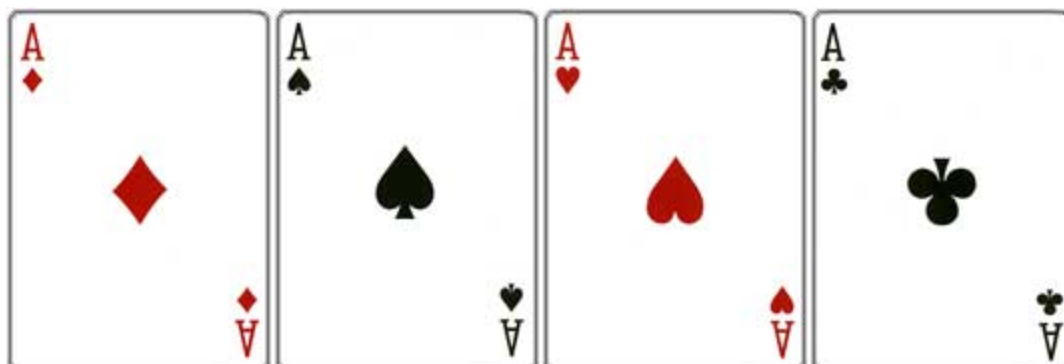


Birth Cards:

Aces



We know from the Book of John in the Bible that, "In the beginning was the Word." If we deeply understand that, then we understand Aces. The Ace is representative of the primary masculine element. The Ace is the creative principal. From Genesis, we know God created heaven and earth. This was done by the Word; "and God said, let it be so." Aces are great communicators and they are forever communicating either on the phone, computer or directly with others who seem to surround them. But Aces are also loners and can be absorbed with themselves alone. Think of the Aries who is self-absorbed. They need some kind of tangible results in order to be content. Relationships that do not give them what they want are ended. The Ace of Hearts is personified in the "Search for Self" more so than other Aces. While all Aces have undertaken this search their suit tells us in which area of life they are most interested. Ace of Hearts people search for themselves in their love and friendship relationships. The Ace of Clubs searches for meaning in books read and things they are interested in. The Ace of Diamonds is conflicted. They do not know whether to find fulfillment in their ambition or the need for companionship or marriage. Like the Ace of Hearts, they want perfect love in order to be completed. The Ace is the beginning and the creator. All things stem from it.
