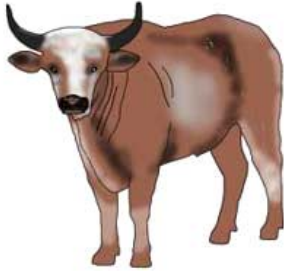


Chinese and Western Combinations

Combination with Tiger Year:

"Utilize" Saturn, Earth, Cardinal
