Libra (Dog) Month

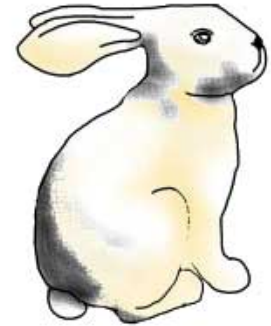
Combination with Rabbit Year:

The Libra-Rabbit tends to be a homebody. Earning the trust of this combination takes times because they refrain from taking any sort of leap of faith.
