Pisces (Rabbit) Month

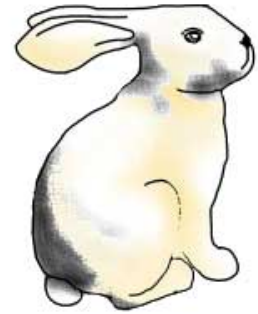
Combination with Rabbit Year:
