


Chinese and Western Combinations

Pisces (Rabbit) Month

Combination with Tiger Year:



"Faith" Neptune, Water, Mutable

"Observe" Yang-Positive Wood

Characteristics: Indecision, Authority, Spirituality, Itinerancy, Benevolence, Intemperance, Awareness, Rage, Fearfulness, Smugness, Perception, Magnetism, Disobedience, Compatibility, Bravery, Fervor, Lack of Will, Hotheadedness, Good Luck, Creativity, Understanding, Diffidence, Impetuosity, Swagger



This combination loves vast oceans and never-ending space. Boundaries, fences, bars and shackles bother them and have no importance to them. The Fish envies the free bird. Their goals and their interests are much more in the area of the spiritual illumination. That has a great appeal to them. The Pisces-Tiger is more the latter than the former in spite of the fact that they do not always like it. They search, often in vain, for some kind of self-identity. The Tiger part of their being makes them feel limited even though it is spirited. The unbounded and the limitless appeal to them. Vanity is generally part of the mixture.
