Taurus (Snake) Month

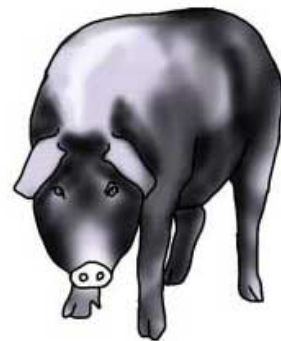
Combination with Boar Year:
