Virgo (Rooster) Month

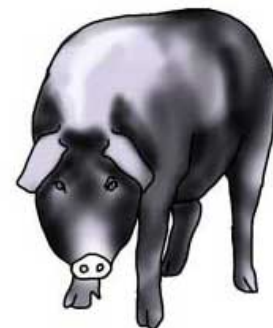
Combination with Boar Year:
